POSITION SUMMARY:

Assist in the maintenance and grounds upkeep of all zoo buildings, exhibits, structures, barriers, assorted walkways, paved surfaces and other designated areas throughout the zoo.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS:

- Minimum 18 years of age with a valid driver's license.
- Ability to work with general directions, alone or in a group.
- Ability to plan, organize and handle multiple tasks as necessary.
- General working knowledge of construction, fencing, grounds upkeep, repair techniques and procedures.
- Experience with a zero radius lawn mower and the ability to use a chain saw as well as other assorted medium and light powered equipment.
- Ability to interpret, diagnose, speculate, and communicate ideas and instructions to and from zoo staff.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Courteously and safely assisting zoo departments with maintenance and grounds needs.
- Planting, seeding, pruning, weeding, mulching, fertilizing, watering, mowing and the trimming of trees, shrubs, gardens and turf as needed with the use of loppers, hand saws, push lawn mower, weed eaters, etc.
- Maintaining the order and neatness of exhibit and guest space.
- Setting up hoses and sprinklers in and around animal exhibits.
- Using vehicles, shovels and rakes to move materials including slag, woodchips and snow.
- Installing, replacing and repairing tree guards in and around animal exhibits.
- Working with contractors, as needed, on pest control, irrigation, tree removal and other grounds projects.
- Operating automatic and standard shift vehicles, hand held and/or power tools and equipment, occasionally heavy equipment and hazardous chemicals safely.
- Communicating regularly using a hand held radio.
- Adhering to all safety policies and procedures as prescribed by Binder Park Zoo, OSHA and MIOSHA.
- Maintaining all tools, equipment, safety devices, and vehicles to ensure proper function and use.
- Relating positively with diverse groups of people (guests, staff and volunteers).

OTHER DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Complying with all Binder Park Zoo policies and procedures.
- Participating in team-oriented zoo projects as needed.
- Assisting with maintenance and grounds safety logs, preventative maintenance logs, and work orders.
- Participating in zoo committees pertinent to maintenance and grounds responsibilities for the zoo's mission.
- Assisting in training seasonal zoo physical plant staff.
- Keeping the Facilities Manager informed of the status of facilities and equipment regularly.
